**Ordinance 2017-12 Indigent Burial Reimbursement (first reading)**

Call from Wellman's Funeral home regarding indigent resident passed away, and we are responsible for burial/cremation; bill is for \$2575. Ashville only pays Social Security death benefit amount, so therefore our reimbursement will be \$255.

**Ordinance 2017-13 Part Time General Laborer Position (first reading)**
