

~~WHEREAS: THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY OHIO WOULD LIKE TO HAVE A SNOW REMOVAL POLICY TO DEFINE THE AREAS OF SNOW REMOVAL, PARKING RESTRICTIONS, PROCEDURES FOR SNOW REMOVAL AND DEFINE WHAT / WHO SETS A SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARATION.~~

WHEREAS: IT IS NECESSARY TO DEFINE THE TERMS OF VILLAGE ROADWAY, VEHICLE, SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARATION, PROHIBITED PARKING, REMOVAL OF VEHICLES, SNOW PLACEMENT, SIDEWALKS, AND ORDINANCE 2008-15 IS INSUFFICIENT TO DO SO.

THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD, PICKAWAY COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: ORDINANCE 2008-15 IS HEREBY REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRITY.

SECTION 2: THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD COUNCIL ADOPTS THE FOLLOWING SNOW EMERGENCY AND REMOVAL POLICY IN REPLACEMENT OF 2008-15:

SECTION 3: DEFINING TERMS:

- A) "VEHICLE" AS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE MEANS ANY MOTOR VEHICLE AS DEFINED IN THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND ANY TRAILOR, BOAT, OR INORPERABLE CAR, TRUCK OR CAMPER.
- B) "ROADWAY" AS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE MEANS ANY PAVED SURFACE OF ROADWAY AND ALLEYS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH BLOOMFIELD CORPORATION LIMITS.

SECTION 4: SNOW EMERGENGE DECLARATION:

- A) WHENEVER SNOW FALLS IN THE VILLAGE, OR IN ANY SECTION THEREOF, TO A DEPTH TO CAUSE THE PICKAWAY COUNTY SHERIFF TO DETERMINE A SNOW EMERGENCY IS DECLARED TO EXIST IN THAT SUCH A DEPTH OF SNOW CONSTITUTES A SERIOUS PUBLIC HAZARD, IMPAIRING TRANSPORTATION, THE MOVEMENT OF FOOD, FUEL AND OTHER SUPPLIES, MEDICAL CARE, FIRE, HEALTH AND POLICE PROTECTION AND OTHER VITAL FACILITIES OF THE VILLAGE. SUCH EMERGENCY SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL AN ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE PICKAWAY COUNTY SHERIFF OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE THAT THE ROADWAY ADVISORY HAS BEEN LIFTED COUNTY WIDE.
- B) THE SHERIFF OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE SHALL MAKE A REASONABLE EFFORT TO ANNOUNCE THE EXISTENCE OF THE EMERGENCY BY USE OF LOCAL PRESS, RADIO, SOCIAL MEDIA AND TELEVISION STATIONS, AND SHALL MAKE SIMILAR REASONABLE EFFORTS TO ANNOUNCE THE TERMINATION OF SUCH EMERGENCY. THE SNOW EMERGENCY SHALL BE IN EFFECT EXPRESSLY LIFTED BY THE SHERIFF OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE. HOWEVER, OWNERS AND OPERATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES SHALL HAVE THE RESPONSIBLITIESTO DETERMINE EXISTING WEATHER CONDITIONS AND TO COMPLY WITH EMERGENCY PARKING REGULATIONS WHEN SUCH EMERGENCY IS IN EFFECT.
