An Ordinance to create a Full Time Police officer for the Village South Bloomfield

Whereas, the Village has the necessity to add another full time police officer to the village to protect the residents and enforce the Ordinances of the Village of South Bloomfield and,

Whereas, the Village Finance Committee has approved the expense for the addition of one full time police officer and,

Whereas, the Mayor of South Bloomfield Matt Pettibone has requested this be passed as an emergency for the need of public safety and,


Whereas, Officer Ben Skeens has served for the village as an auxiliary officer and has demonstrated a commitment to his profession, a willingness to learn and develop as a police officer, and a level of honesty, integrity and passion to protect and serve the community of South Bloomfield.


Therefore, be it ordained by the Village of South Bloomfield, Pickaway County, State of Ohio, that...

Section One: Officer Ben Skeens is hired effective December 7th 2015


Section Two: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and remain in full force after the earliest period allowed by law.
