

**Ordinance 2016-14** To Create an Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board

**Whereas**, Chapter 143.02 of the Ohio Revised Code requires every political subdivision employing Auxiliary Police Officers to establish an Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board and,

**Whereas**, the Village of South Bloomfield employs Auxiliary Police Officers

**Therefore**, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of South Bloomfield, Pickaway County, State of Ohio that

- Section 1 An Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board is hereby created.
- Section 2 Pursuant to 143.02 (A) (1), (2), (3) of the Ohio Revised Code the board shall consist of
- A Two board members, elected by the Council for the Village of South Bloomfield
  - B Two board members, elected by the Auxiliary Police Officers
  - C One board member, elected by the board members elected in Section 2 (A) and (B) of this ordinance.
- Section 3 The term of office for each board member begins the first day of January and is for one year.
- Section 4 The members of this board are to be elected on or before the second Monday in December.
- Section 5 The Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board shall meet promptly after election of the board's members and organize. The board shall select from among its members a chairperson and a secretary.
- Section 6 The Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board may adopt rules as necessary for handling and processing claims for benefits.
- Section 7 The Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board shall serve without compensation.
- Section 8 This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and remain in full force after the earliest period allowed by law.
