Ordinance 2016-14 To Create an Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board

Whereas, Chapter 143.02 of the Ohio Revised Code requires every political subdivision employing Auxiliary Police Officers to establish an Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board and,

Whereas, the Village of South Bloomfield employs Auxiliary Police Officers

Therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of South Bloomfield, Pickaway County, State of Ohio that

- Section 1 An Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board is hereby created.
- Section 2 Pursuant to 143.02 (A) (1), (2), (3) of the Ohio Revised Code the board shall consist of
 - A Two board members, elected by the Council for the Village of South Bloomfield
 - B Two board members, elected by the Auxiliary Police Officers
 - One board member, elected by the board members elected in Section 2 (A) and (B) of this ordinance.
- Section 3 The term of office for each board member begins the first day of January and is for one year.
- Section 4 The members of this board are to be elected on or before the second Monday in December.
- Section 5 The Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board shall meet promptly after election of the board's members and organize. The board shall select from among its members a chairperson and a secretary.
- Section 6 The Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board may adopt rules as necessary for handling and processing claims for benefits.
- Section 7 The Auxiliary Police Officer's Dependents Board shall serve without compensation.
- Section 8 This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and remain in full force after the earliest period allowed by law.
