

Ordinance 2017-07

An ordinance to establish a Motor Vehicle Tax pursuant to Sections 4504.06 and 4504.172 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Whereas, the appropriations for street maintenance received from the State of Ohio has not increased and,

Whereas, the cost associated with maintaining and improving the streets in the village has increased,

Therefore, be it ordained by the Council for the Village of South Bloomfield, Pickaway County, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1** Ordinance 2016-09 Municipal Motor Vehicle Tax (attached) is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety.
- Section 2** Pursuant to Section 4504.06 of the Ohio Revised Code allowing Municipalities to levy an annual license tax for the purpose of paying the costs and expenses of enforcing and administering the tax provided for in this section; and for planning, constructing, improving, maintaining, and repairing public roads, highways, and streets; maintaining and repairing bridges and viaducts; paying the municipal corporation's portion of the costs and expenses of cooperating with the department of transportation in the planning, improvement, and construction of state highways; paying the municipal corporation's portion of the compensation, damages, cost, and expenses of planning, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, and repairing roads and streets; paying any costs apportioned to the municipal corporation under section 4907.47 of the Revised Code; paying debt service charges on notes or bonds of the municipal corporation issued for such purposes; purchasing, erecting, and maintaining street and traffic signs and markers; purchasing, erecting and maintaining traffic lights and signals; and to supplement revenue already available for such purposes. A tax of five dollars, \$5.00, is hereby enacted.
- Section 3** Pursuant to Section 4504.172 of the Ohio Revised Code allowing for Municipalities to levy a supplemental municipal license tax for the purpose of paying the costs and expenses of enforcing and administering the tax provided for in this section; to supplement revenue already available to municipal corporations under section 4504.04, 4504.06, 4504.17, or 4507.171 of the Revised Code, and to provide additional revenue for the purposes set forth in those sections. A tax of five dollars, \$5.00, is hereby enacted
- Section 4** Such taxes shall be levied on each and every motor vehicle whose registration as defined in section 4505.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, is the Village of South Bloomfield, Ohio.
- Section 5** As used in this ordinance the term "motor vehicle" means any and all vehicles included within the definition of motor vehicle in sections 4501.01 and 4505.01 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 6** The taxes levied by this ordinance shall apply to and be effective for the registration year commencing January 1, 2018 and shall continue in effect and application during each registration year thereafter.

Section 7 The tax imposed by this ordinance shall be paid to the Registrar of Motor Vehicles of the State of Ohio or to a Deputy Registrar at the time application for registration of a motor vehicle is made as provided in section 4503.10 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 8 All monies derived from the tax levied shall be used by the Village of South Bloomfield for the purposes specified in this ordinance.


Section 9 This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and remain in full force after the earliest period allowed by law.
